Students will help build a multiethnic Macedonia

As of yesterday, more than 400 students from the universities in Skopje, Bitola, Tetovo and the South East European University started attending the Summer University of Macedonia, whose aim is to stimulate the interuniversity collaboration.

The students will be attending courses in law, economy, business and public administration, pedagogy, as well as tribunes, excursions and workshops.

-Ninety percent of the ethnic communities are included in the education process and have the opportunity to study in their native language. It may seem that the students are separated on ethnical basis, but is not so. All the curricula are alike, and from this year that will be the case with the history books as well. We will all enjoy a multiethnic and multicultural Macedonia – Aziz Polozani, Minister of Education said.

The International Summer University is financed by the Embassy of the Kingdom of the Netherlands in Macedonia. The Ambassador of the Netherlands in Macedonia Fredericka De Mann says that the summer programme will influence positively the conducting of the Framework Agreement. The project is carried out by the Academic Training Association from Holland, and the courses will be held until 22nd of July.
