**Doris Pack: The borders will not be altered; there will be no great Albania**

Resolving the status of Kosovo is not dangerous for Macedonia, because there is one key condition to it, and that is that with the establishing of the status there will be no alterations of the borders, Doris Pack the member of the European Parliament said yesterday in Skopje.

- There is one key condition – the borders will not be altered, not the borders of Macedonia, not the borders of Serbia and Montenegro, nor Albania's borders, meaning there will be no great Albania. I believe that the establishment of the final status of Kosovo will relax the situation in Macedonia a great deal, too.

At the Summer University at the Faculty of Economics in Skopje she held a lecture on regional European perspectives to students of countries in the region. She appealed once more to the leaders of those countries to intensify regional collaboration, since it is one of the key conditions for the European integrations. Macedonia's advance towards the EU, according to Pack, will depend on the fulfillment of the necessary criteria.

- You must work really hard to reach the necessary standards and the doors will be opened for you – Pack said.
